Headteacher's Latest News



School is flourishing in every way at the moment and we are delighted with the start of the year. It has been a fabulous to see so many parents of Headteacher's Award winners coming along to the achievement assemblies. Our Values of Perseverance, Ambition, Responsibility and Kindness are focuses for these assemblies and awards are given out related to these.

Everyone is invited to our Harvest Assembly on Tuesday 21st October at 9.00am. This is an occasion where we support our local community by donating produce to their food banks. This year we are supporting the Daylight Centre and they will be coming along to the assembly. All the children are taking part with a number of Harvest songs. It is taking place in the school hall and it would be lovely to see as many of you as possible to support the children at this wonderful event.

Excellent attendance is a crucial part of school life and research shows that missing school significantly impacts on your child's potential achievements. We encourage all our children to achieve excellent attendance. There are 175 non-school days for holidays and appointments and wherever possible we ask everyone to use these times to book these. If

you take your child out of school for an accumulative total of 5 days or more over a period of 10 weeks you could be referred to the Local Authority for a fine. If your child is unable to attend school for any reason, it is important you phone the school office prior to 8.50am to inform us of the reasons for their absence. We will send you regular updates throughout the year of your child's attendance and we thank you for your co-operation with this.

Our Parents' Evenings this term are Tuesday 10th November and Wednesday 12th November from 3.40pm – 6.00pm. Information will be coming out nearer the time but please put these dates into your diary as it is important all parents come along to see your child's current achievements.

Our extra curricular clubs have started off incredibly well and are superbly attended. We are so fortunate that our staff give their time up so freely to provide these opportunities for our families. Just a reminder for parents and carers to collect children promptly at 4.15pm from the front of school if they have taken part in a club.

Mental Health Support Team (MHST)

Who are we?

Mental Health Support Teams (MHSTs) have been created to offer early intervention, low intensity, mental health support within schools for children and young people with mild to moderate mental health difficulties.

The MHST will also support the Mental Health Lead in each education setting to introduce and develop their Whole School Approach.

The MHST will also offer support and advice to education setting staff to identify the most appropriate services for their need and help liaise with other appropriate services.

The EMHP role

Education Mental Health Practitioners (EMHPs) have a clear criteria to support low level (low intensity) mental health needs such as low mood, anxiety and phobias.

EMHPs are able to provide assessments and evidence based individual and group work. They can also offer onward signposting to other teams and services and whole school projects.

1:1 work is a key aspect of the EMHP role. Weekly intervention sessions are approximately 30-40 minutes long and last 4-8 sessions.
