Some of our Year 5 / 6 Football team took part in the East Northamptonshire football tournament at Redwell Leisure Centre. Well done we are having proud of you all.



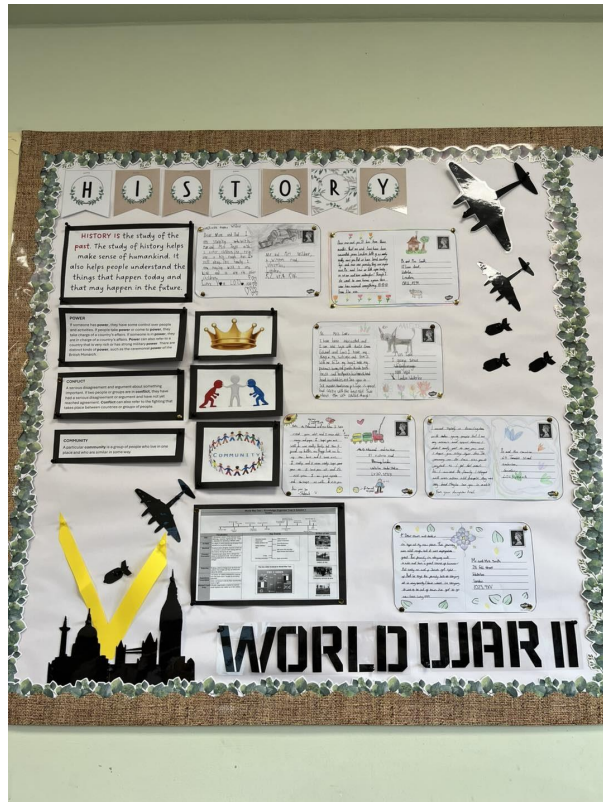
## Super Work

Book and Bake monster marshmallow pops for The Last Kids On Earth graphic novel.



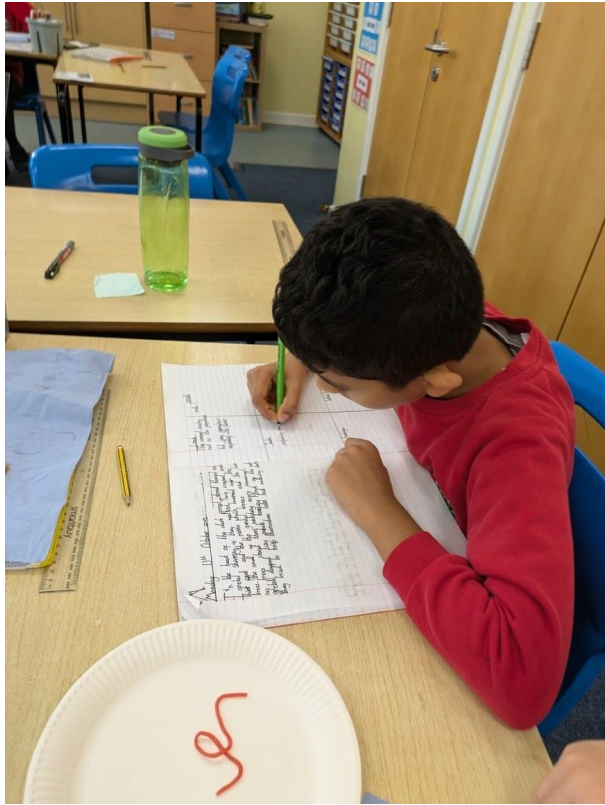

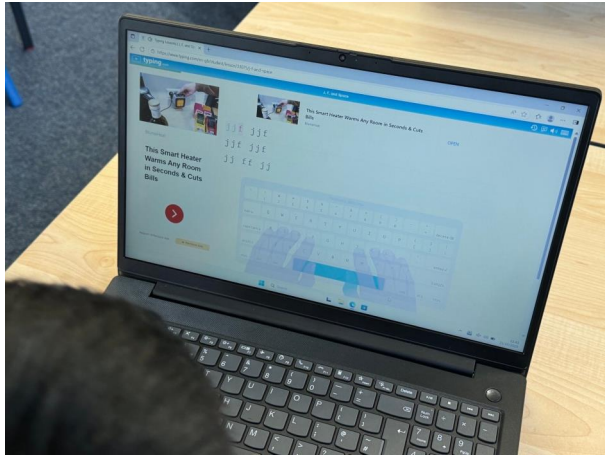




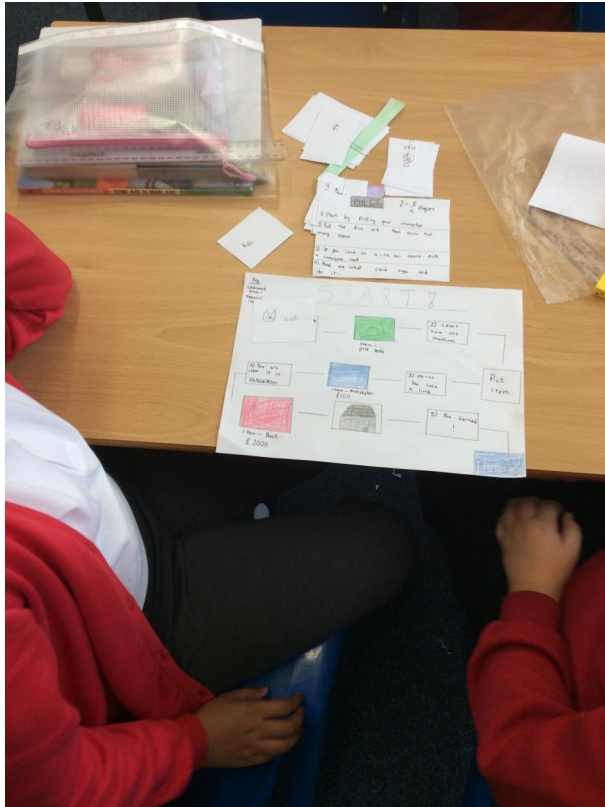
Enjoying our last Book and Bake before half term. Harry Potter and the Prisoner of Azkaban with delicious butter beer milkshakes
