Remote Learning Plan November 2020

It is now an expectation that children will continue to learn at home in the event of self-isolation or the closure of a bubble; schools are responsible for providing learning activities and parents are responsible for delivering this learning to their child/ren.

During the ongoing Covid-19 pandemic, it is possible that individuals or groups of children will be unable to attend school. In these instances, we will continue to provide high quality education and support to children using Microsoft Teams. This will be a blended approach of recorded lessons and assignments/activities set. This learning may include links to online resources such as White Rose Maths, Oak Academy and BBC Bitesize. Teachers will be able to provide support and feedback using Microsoft Teams. Our rich integrated curriculum is carefully planned to enable children to develop knowledge and skills in all curriculum areas, underpinned by our learning values and with a strong focus on reading, writing and maths. This is something we will continue to prioritise in our learning model.

Home Learning Top Tips For Parents/Carers

Top tips for supporting families working at home:

- Opening your new school: establish a place for your children to work from and get them involved in setting up their learning area. Gather resources such as pencils, pens, paper, laptop/tablet, books etc.
- Establish routine: draw up a plan with your child for each day so that they can see what work they will be completing when. Children react well to structured routines. Remember to include physical and mental breaks to help them with their learning.
- Encouraging good habits with positive interactions: talk through the learning with your child. Make sure your child knows what is expected and how to complete the tasks independently.

Safeguarding

There may be an occasional live lesson for your child with their class and teacher. We ask the children's camera and microphone is switched off. If children have questions they will be able to 'virtually raise their hand' and then they will be invited to switch on their microphone. However, in the event there is a delay in switching these off, we ask the children are dressed appropriately, seated in a quiet and well lit room with no other family members present. All live sessions will be recorded by their teacher and stored securely within the school's environment. These recordings will not be used in the public domain other than for safeguarding purposes.
